## ITINERARY

### 1. Colosseum

Piazza del Colosseo, 1, 00184 Roma RM, Italy

**1 hour 15 minutes** • time: Morning • *landmark*

Rome's iconic amphitheater that hosted gladiatorial contests and public spectacles in the 1st century AD.

**Try:** Explore the hypogeum level (if available)

**Tips:**

- Enter through the underground arena floor entrance for a shorter queue
- Book the timed entry ticket online to avoid the main gate line

### 2. Roman Forum

Via della Salara Vecchia, 5/6, 00186 Roma RM, Italy

**50 minutes** • time: Morning • *landmark*



The bustling heart of ancient Rome, packed with temples, basilicas, and the Senate House.

**Try:** Stand where Julius Caesar reportedly addressed the crowd

**Tips:**

- Enter via the side gate near the Arch of Titus for a quieter entrance
- Carry a water bottle; shaded areas are limited

— 5 min walk from previous stop —

### 3. Palatine Hill

Via di San Silvestro, 00186 Roma RM, Italy

**45 minutes** •time: Morning • *park*

Legendary birthplace of Rome, offering ruins of imperial palaces and panoramic city views.

**Try:** Enjoy the view over the Circus Maximus

**Tips:**

- Take the path to the Farnese Gardens for the best view
- Visit early to avoid crowds on the terrace

— 12 min walk from previous stop —

### 4. Capitoline Museums

Piazza del Campidoglio, 1, 00186 Roma RM, Italy

**1 hour 30 minutes** •time: Late Morning • *museum*

World's oldest public museums, showcasing ancient sculptures, Renaissance art and the famous Capitoline Wolf.

**Try:** See the bronze statue of Marcus Aurelius

**Tips:**

- Enter through the rear staircase to skip the ticket line crowd
- Don't miss the Sala dei Pianeti with its dramatic ceiling

— 11 min walk from previous stop —

### 5. Taverna dei Fori Imperiali

Via della Madonna dei Monti, 9, 00184 Roma RM, Italy

**1 hour** •time: Afternoon • *restaurant*



Familyrun trattoria near the Forum serving classic Roman dishes in a cozy setting.

**Try:** Cacio e pepe pasta

**Tips:**

- Ask for the daily 'speciale della casa' for authentic flavors
- Reserve a table for 2 to avoid waiting at lunch

## 6. Piazza Navona

Piazza Navona, 00186 Roma RM, Italy

**30 minutes** •time: Afternoon • landmark

Elegant Baroque square built on an ancient stadium, famous for Bernini's Fountain of the Four Rivers.

**Try:** Snap a photo of the Fountain of the Four Rivers

**Tips:**

- Sit on the stairs of the north fountain for a great photo
- Visit early to hear street musicians without crowds

— 5 min walk from previous stop —

## 7. Pantheon

Piazza della Rotonda, 00186 Roma RM, Italy

**35 minutes** •time: Afternoon • landmark

A 2,000yearold temple with a monumental dome and the world's largest unreinforced concrete vault.

**Try:** Observe the beam of light through the oculus

**Tips:**

- Enter through the side door to avoid the main queue during peak hours
- Look up to admire the oculus and its moving sunbeam

— 6 min walk from previous stop —

## 8. Campo de' Fiori Market

Piazza Campo de' Fiori, 00186 Roma RM, Italy

**45 minutes** •time: Afternoon • market



Vibrant daily market offering fresh produce, local cheeses, and street food amid historic buildings.

**Try:** Taste fresh mozzarella and sundried tomatoes

**Tips:**

- Buy a slice of pizza bianca from a stall for a quick bite
- Visit the central fountain for a photo with locals

— 15 min walk or 5 min bus from previous stop —

### 9. Osteria da Zi' Umberto

Via Giovanni Branca, 88, 00153 Roma RM, Italy

**2 hours** •time: Evening • *restaurant*

Traditional Trastevere osteria known for hearty Roman fare and a warm, familystyle atmosphere.

**Try:** Coda alla vaccinara

**Tips:**

- Ask for the 'coda alla vaccinara' (ox tail stew) – a true Roman specialty
- Sit outside in the courtyard for a lively evening vibe

— 12 min walk from previous stop —

### 10. Gianicolo Hill Viewpoint

Via Garibaldi, 00153 Roma RM, Italy

**30 minutes** •time: Evening • *viewpoint*

One of Rome's highest panoramas, offering sweeping views of the city skyline at sunset.

**Try:** Sunset over the city

**Tips:**

- Climb the steps to the Terrazzino for the best photo of St. Peter's dome
- Bring a light jacket; it gets breezy after dusk

- Wear comfortable shoes for cobblestones
